Disclaimer

Overnight field trips in the LE program are optional. Should you choose NOT to send your child, he/she will be expected to attend school as usual. If you do choose to send him/her on an overnight trip, all money must be paid at least two weeks prior to the trip. If you would like to make payments, a schedule can be set up in advance of the trip. In this case, all payments must still be received two weeks before the trip in order for your child to attend.
